Dear Partners in the Gospel,

As many of you know, we currently rent a room in a local movie theater for our Sunday morning services. We are so glad to have a nice, comfortable, and affordable place where we can worship the Lord together. Complementing the Sunday worship services, we have recently begun **home groups** that are allowing us to spend quality time with other followers of Christ. Many of the people in our church do not come from Christian families, and they do not have Christian friends. As a result, the home groups provide opportunities to spend time with other believers, to talk about faith and life, and to pray together.

In order to lay a good foundation for the future, we decided to have all the groups go through a study called *Growing Together: discipleship in the local church*. We currently have over 40 people participating in four different home groups. There are three home groups meeting in different homes and one group that is meeting virtually (for those who cannot participate in person due to distance and/or work schedules). It has been encouraging to see people in our church open their homes, others facilitating the biblical conversations, and friendships developing.

Home groups have great potential to set a biblical trajectory for the future of our local church and for other churches that God would allow IBCV to start. *How?* Consider our mission and our vision. As a local church, we have intentionally defined our mission and our vision:

Our *mission* as a local church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ.

Our *vision* as a local church is to send believers out from our local congregation to plant other local churches.

Our prayer is that the home groups will be a catalyst for helping us, as a local church and as individual believers, make disciples of Jesus Christ through the local church. Perhaps some of these home groups will lead to the establishment of biblical, local churches for the glory of God.

We focus on three purposes. (1) Spend time together. (2) Study God's Word together. (3) Pray together. We are seeing that each of these purposes is vital and necessary for us as believers.
